AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE PARTY WOODS CROSS CITY TO INCLUDE THE ANNEXATION OF THE PARTY FOR WOODS CROSS CITY REAL PROPERTY LOCATED WEST OF REDWOOD ROAD AT APPROXIMATELY 1400 SOUTH, AND AMENDING THE WOODS CROSS CITY ZONING MAP TO ZONE AND DESIGNATE PORTIONS OF THIS AREA AS R-1-8 SINGLE FAMILY AND A-1 AGRICULTURAL UPON ITS ANNEXATION TO THE CITY.

WHEREAS, there has been filed with the City Recorder of Woods Cross City a petition by Ivory Land Corporation and Ivory Development LLC, together with an annexation plat showing the territory to be annexed and requesting that the property described in the petition to be annexed within the corporate limits of Woods Cross City; and

WHEREAS, the petition is signed by a majority of the owners of the real property and the owners of more than one-third in value of all real property within the territory to be annexed as shown in the last assessment roll; and

WHEREAS, the Woods Cross City Council on the 20th day of January 2009 accepted said petition for consideration; and

WHEREAS, notice as required by law had been given to the public and to any affected entity regarding the proposed annexation; and

WHEREAS, no objection or protest of such annexation has been received by the Davis County Boundary Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Woods Cross City Council, after examining said petition, having received a recommendation from the Planning Commission, having the petition reviewed by the City staff, having considered the circumstances thereof at a properly advertised and noticed public hearing, and after finding said proposed annexation to be consistent and in keeping with the City's General Plan; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF WOODS CROSS CITY, STATE OF UTAH, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1 Annexation. The Woods Cross City limits are hereby enlarged and extended so as to include the below-described real property west of the current boundary of Woods Cross City, including approximately 0.7891 acres of unincorporated territory in Davis County, State of Utah. The specific territory hereby annexed is more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING AT A POINT ON THE EXISTING WOODS CROSS CITY BOUNDARY, SAID POINT BEING N0°12'36"W, 2027.59 FEET ALONG THE SECTION LINE AND WEST, 334.50 FEET FROM THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 27, TOWNSHIP 2 NORTH, RANGE 1 WEST, SALT LAKE BASE AND MERIDIAN AND RUNING THENCE ALONG THE EXISTING WOODS CROSS CITY BOUNDARY LINE DUE WEST, 1951.83 FEET TO THE WEST LINE OF THE LEGACY HIGHWAY CORRIDOR; THENCE LEAVING THE EXISTING WOODS CROSS CITY BOUNDARY AND RUNNING ALONG SAID CORRIDOR N02° 53'06"E, 17.64 FEET; THENCE EAST, 1950.87 FEET TO THE EXISTING WOODS CROSS CITY BOUNDARY; THENCE S00°12'37"E, 17.62 FEET ALONG THE EXISTING WOODS CROSS CITY BOUNDARY TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING.

CONTAINS: 0.7891 ACRES

Section 2 Zoning. Be it further ordained and declared that the territory described in Section 1 hereof, according to the boundaries shown on the map attached hereto as Exhibit A, is hereby designated R-1-8 Single Family and A-1 Agricultural.

The property zoned A-1 Agricultural is more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the existing Woods Cross City boundary, said point being N 00°12'36" W, 2027.59 feet along the Section Line and West 334.50 feet from the Southeast Corner of Section 27, Township 2 North, Range 1 West, Salt Lake Base and Meridian and running thence along the existing Woods Cross City boundary line due West, 274.00 feet; Thence leaving the existing Woods Cross City boundary and running N 00°12'37" E, 17.62 feet; Thence East 274.00 feet to the existing Woods Cross City boundary; Thence S 00°12'37" E, 17.62 feet eleng the existing Woods Cross City boundary to the point of beginning. Contains: 4,828 sq feet.

The property zoned R-1-8 Single Family is more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the existing Woods Cross City boundary, said point being N 00°12'36" W, 2027.59 feet along the Section Line and West 608.50 feet from the Southeast Corner of Section 27, Township 2 North, Range 1 West, Salt Lake Base and Meridian and running thence along the existing Woods Cross City boundary line due West, 1677.83 feet to the west line of Legacy Highway corridor; Thence leaving the existing Woods Cross City boundary and running along said corridor N 02°53'06" E, 17.64 feet; Thence East 1676.87 feet; Thence S 00°12'37" E, 17.62 feet to the point of beginning. Contains: 29,546 sq feet

The Woods Cross City zoning map is hereby correspondingly amended.

Section 3 General Jurisdiction. Be it further ordained and declared that the said territory described above in Section 1 shall henceforth be within the Woods Cross City corporate limits and shall be zoned as provided in Section 2 hereof. All ordinances, jurisdictions, rules, and obligations of, or pertaining to, Woods Cross City, are extended over and made applicable and pertinent to the above tract of land and all streets, blocks, alleys and ways of said tract shall be controlled and governed by the ordinances, rules and regulations of Woods Cross City.

Section 4 Filings and Notice. The Woods Cross City Recorder is hereby directed to file with the Davis County Recorder, after approval by the City Engineer, a copy of the annexation plat duly certified and acknowledged, together with a certified copy of this Ordinance. Within 30 days after enacting this Ordinance, the City Recorder shall send notice of the enactment to each affected entity and to file with the Lieutenant Governor this Ordinance and notice of this annexation. The City Recorder is further directed to provide notice to the Utah State Tax Commission under the provisions of Section 10-1-116 of *Utah Code Annotated*, 1953 as amended, and to provide notice of the annexation to any special districts servicing the City of Woods Cross.

Section 5 <u>Effective Date of Annexation</u>. The aforesaid annexation shall become effective on the date of the Lieutenant Governor's issuance of a Certification of Annexation for the above-referenced annexation.

Section 6 Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon publication or posting, or 30 days after passage, whichever occurs first.
