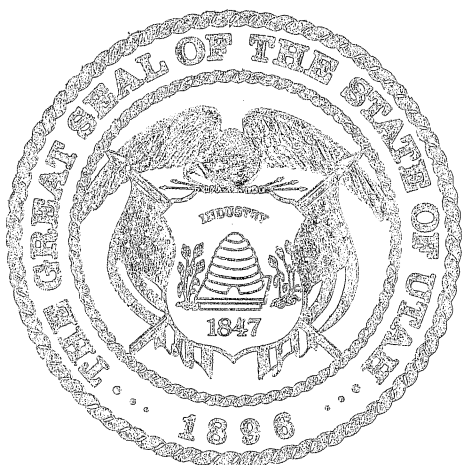

**RESOLUTION NO. R-2017-2238**

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE EXPANSION OF SERVICES OFFERED BY THE  
DAMMERON VALLEY FIRE SPECIAL SERVICE DISTRICT TO INCLUDE  
RECREATION**

WHEREAS, Washington County (the "County") established the Dammeron Valley Fire Special Service District ("DVF SSD") to provide fire protection services to the Dammeron Valley area by Resolution Number 661 on September 29, 1997;

WHEREAS, the park in the Dammeron Valley area located adjacent to the Fire Station is currently being maintained by the DVF SSD on a volunteer basis;

WHEREAS, under to § 17D-1-201 of the Utah Code, the County may delegate the right, power, or authority to include recreation as a service offered by the special service district;

WHEREAS, the administrative control board of DVF SSD passed a motion in a public meeting held August 8, 2016, requesting the County Commission to add parks and recreation to the SSD charter;

WHEREAS, a properly-noticed public hearing was held and the time for filing protests has passed without any protests filed;


WHEREAS, the interests of the residents of Dammeron Valley will best be served by the addition of recreational services to the DVF SSD.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED by the County Commission of Washington County, Utah that the addition of parks and recreation services to the DVF SSD charter is approved.


