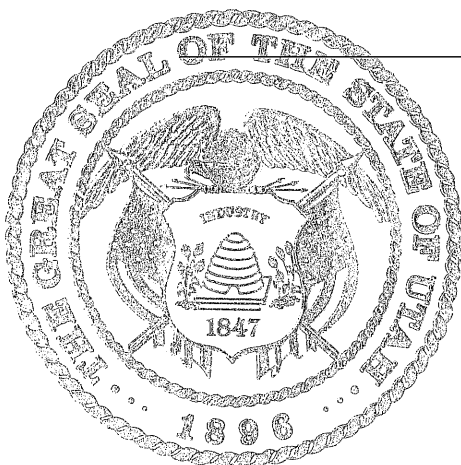

ORDINANCE 563 (2017)**

**ESTABLISHING OF THE GRAND COUNTY COUNCIL AS A
COMMUNITY REINVESTMENT AGENCY (CRA)**

WHEREAS, Title 17C of the Utah State Code, Limited Purpose Local Government Entities – Community Reinvestment Agency Act, as amended to date authorizes a community legislative body to create a community reinvestment agency; and

WHEREAS, the County Council endeavors to utilize tax increment revenue to finance land and economic development activities within the County; and

WHEREAS, due notice was given that the Grand County Council would meet to hear and consider the proposed ordinance to establish itself as a community reinvestment agency in a public hearing on July 5, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the Grand County Council has heard and considered all evidence and testimony presented with respect to the subject legislative act and has determined that the adoption of this ordinance is in the best interests of the citizens of Grand County, Utah;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Grand County Council that the Grand County Council is hereby established as a Community Reinvestment Agency as authorized by Utah State Code.
