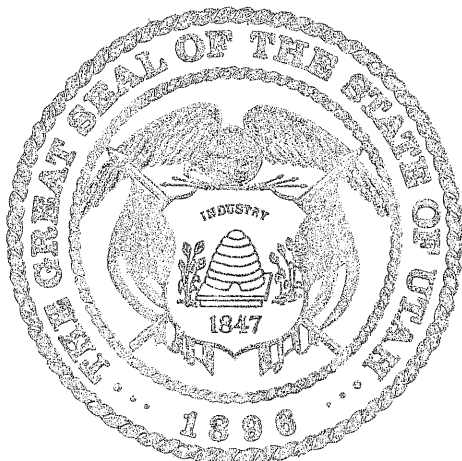

I, SPENCER J. COX, LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF UTAH, HEREBY CERTIFY THAT there has been filed in my office a notice of name change from the WEBER COUNTY SERVICE AREA #5 (LIBERTY PARK) to OGDEN VALLEY PARKS SERVICE AREA, dated June 22, 2017, complying with Section 17B-1-105, Utah Code Annotated, 1953, as amended.

**NOTICE OF NAME CHANGE
FROM
WEBER COUNTY SERVICE AREA #5 (LIBERTY PARK)
TO OGDEN VALLEY PARKS SERVICE AREA**

To the Lieutenant Governor of the State of Utah:

Notice is hereby given in accordance with the requirements of Utah Code Ann. § 17B-1-105(4) as follows:

1. By adopting Utah Code Ann. § 17-50-103(2)(b), the legislature mandated that, without the written consent of the local county, a local district may not use the word “county” in its name after January 1, 2005.
2. By adopting Utah Code Ann. § 17B-1-105, the legislature provided a mechanism that may be used by a district to change the name of the district.
3. As required by Utah Code Ann. § 17B-1-105(4)(b)(i) the Board of Trustees of Weber County Service Area #5 (Liberty Park) (the “Service Area”) held a public hearing on the proposal to change the name of the Service Area to “Ogden Valley Parks Service Area”.
4. No negative comments regarding the proposed name change were received at the public hearing. Consequently, the Board of Trustees adopted a Resolution dated June 22, 2017 approving the name change to “Ogden Valley Parks Service Area”.
5. The Service Area is located entirely in Weber County.
6. By signing this Notice, the undersigned chairman of the Service Area, acting for and on behalf of the Board of Trustees of the Service Area, verifies and certifies that all requirements applicable to the name change have been met.
