RESOLUTION 19-61 (Redford Annexation Petition)

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A PETITION FOR ANNEXATION OF PROPERTY LOCATED AT APPROXIMATELY 1868 WEST 1000 SOUTH

WHEREAS, a petition has been received by Layton City, pursuant to Utah Code Annotated section 10-2-403, petitioning for annexation of certain properties located at approximately 1868 West and 1000 South; and

WHEREAS, these properties are located within an area where Layton City can provide urban services; and

WHEREAS, these properties are identified in the Layton City Annexation Policy Plan, Expansion Area Five, adopted by the City Council on December 5, 2002; and

WHEREAS, the City Council determines it to be in the best interest of the citizens of Layton City to accept the petition for annexation and direct staff to certify the annexation petition and provide notice thereof relative to the proposed annexation; and

WHEREAS, the property owners wish to proceed with the petition for annexation to the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF LAYTON, UTAH:

- 1. The City has received a petition for annexation presented by Chris Bratsch, designated agent for Husky Real Estate LLC, owner of approximately 3.546 acres, located at approximately 1868 West 1000 North.
- 2. The above properties, more particularly described in 'Exhibit A' which is attached hereto and made a part hereof by reference, represents one hundred percent (100%) of the private land and constitutes one hundred percent (100%) of the value of all private property within the area proposed for annexation.
- 3. The petition is hereby accepted by the City, and staff is hereby directed to certify the petition for the proposed annexation pursuant to Utah Code Annotated and initiate the necessary annexation procedures.

ORDINANCE 20-03

(Redford Annexation)

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING REAL PROPERTIES LOCATED AT APPROXIMATELY 1868 WEST AND 1000 SOUTH INTO THE CITY AND EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF LAYTON CITY; PROVIDING FOR REPEALER, SEVERABILITY, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City has determined that the properties located at approximately 1868 West and 1000 South are part of an existing unincorporated parcel of property contiguous to Layton City; and

WHEREAS, these properties are identified in the Layton City Annexation Policy Plan, Expansion Area Five, adopted by the City Council on December 5, 2002; and

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted Resolutions 19-61 and 19-62 expressing Layton City's intent to annex said properties; and

WHEREAS, a plat of said real properties has been prepared under the supervision of a competent surveyor, showing the size and location of said real properties and showing that the same is contiguous to the present corporate limits of Layton City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that in their judgment, this annexation meets the standards set forth in the Utah State Code, and the noticing requirements therein have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, the Layton City Council deems it to be in the best interest of the City and its citizens to annex the real property described herein to Layton City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF LAYTON, UTAH:

<u>SECTION I:</u> Repealer. If any provisions of the City's Code heretofore adopted are inconsistent herewith they are hereby repealed.

SECTION II: Enactment. That the following described real property is hereby annexed into Layton City, and the corporate limits of the City are hereby extended to include said real property:

A part of the Southwest Quarter of Section 30, Township 4 North Range 1 West, Salt Lake Base and Meridian:

BEGINNING AT A POINT ON THE NORTH LINE OF THE CURRENT LAYTON CITY ANNEXATION LINE AS DETERMINED BY ORDINANCE NO. 839 AND RECORDED IN THE OFFICE OF THE DAVIS COUNTY RECORDER ON APRIL 18, 1989 AS ENTRY NO. 854983 IN BOOK 1287 AT PAGE 799, SAID POINT OF BEGINNING BEING SOUTH 89°57'40" WEST 723.51 FEET ALONG THE SECTION LINE AND NORTH 0°12'50" EAST 217.75 FEET FROM THE SOUTH QUARTER CORNER OF SECTION 30, TOWNSHIP 4 NORTH, RANGE 1 WEST, SALT LAKE BASE AND MERIDIAN, AND RUNNING;

THENCE NORTH 46°34'40" WEST 22.18 FEET ALONG THE SAID LAYTON CITY ANNEXATION LINE; THENCE SOUTH 89°57'40" WEST 367.00 FEET ALONG THE NORTH LINE SAID LAYTON CITY ANNEXATION LINE TO THE EAST LINE OF LAYTON PARKE ESTATES PHASE 3: THENCE NORTH 0°11'01" EAST 356.00 FEET ALONG THE EAST LINE TO THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF LAYTON PARKE ESTATES PHASE 3 AND BEING ON THE SOUTH LINE OF LAYTON PARKE ESTATES PHASE 1; THENCE NORTH 89°57'40" EAST 358.85 FEET ALONG THE SOUTH LINE TO THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF LAYTON

PARKE ESTATES PHASE 1; THENCE NORTH 0°12'50" EAST 731.31 FEET ALONG THE EAST LINE OF LAYTON PARKE ESTATES PHASE 1 TO AND ALONG THE EAST LINE OF LAYTON PARKE ESTATES PHASE 1 – FIRST AMENDED TO AND ALONG THE EAST LINE TO THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF LAYTON PARKE ESTATES PHASE 1 AND BEING ON THE CENTER LINE OF LAYTON PARKWAY; THENCE NORTH 89°57'21" EAST 24.50 FEET ALONG THE CENTER LINE OF LAYTON PARKWAY; THENCE SOUTH 0°12'50" WEST 1102.57 FEET TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING.

CONTAINS 154,481 SQUARE FEET, 3.546 ACRES.

SECTION III: Filing. The City Recorder is directed to file a certified copy of the plat of said real property and a certified copy of this ordinance of annexation with the Davis County Recorder; and within 60 days after the enactment hereof, the City Council shall file with the Lieutenant Governor a notice of impending boundary action, as defined in Section 67-1a-6.5 UCA that meets the requirements of Section 67-1a-6.5(3) UCA and a copy of an approved final plat, as defined in Section 67-1a-6.5.

SECTION IV: Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, said portion shall be severed and such declaration shall not affect the validity of the remainder of the said ordinance.

SECTION V: Effective date. This ordinance shall go into effect at the expiration of the 20th day after publication or posting or the 30th day after final passage as noted below or whichever of said days is more remote from the date of passage thereof.
