ORDINANCE NO. 0-2020-02

AN ORDINANCE ADJUSTING THE COMMON BOUNDARIES BETWEEN LEHI AND HIGHLAND CITY

WHEREAS, the City Council of Highland City finds that, *Utah Code Ann.* § 10-2-419 establishes a procedure for adjustment of the common boundaries between adjacent municipalities; and

WHEREAS, Lehi City shares certain common boundaries with Highland City, and Highland City received a request from the owner of real property within Lehi City but contiguous to Highland City that the owner's property be transferred from the municipal jurisdiction of Highland City to Lehi City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of Highland City approved Resolution No. R-2019-23 on November 12, 2019 stating its intent to adjust its common boundary with Lehi City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of Highland City received no written protests to the proposed boundary adjustment by the deadline for receiving written protests, and held a public hearing on January 14, 2020 to consider approving the proposed boundary adjustment and received public comment on the proposed boundary adjustment; and

WHEREAS, the required public hearing was advertised as required by *Utah Code Ann.* § 10-2-419 and no protests were received by the Highland City protesting the proposed boundary adjustment; and

WHEREAS, the proposed boundary adjustment is in the public interest.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE Highland City Council as follows:

SECTION 1. The City Council acknowledges receipt of a written request from the owner of the real property hereinafter described requesting that its property be transferred from the municipal jurisdiction of Highland City and annexed to Lehi City in accordance with the terms of *Utah Code Ann*. § 10-2-419. The legal description of the land to be removed from the municipal jurisdiction of Highland City is set forth below and shown in the attached Exhibit A:

LEHI / HIGHLAND BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION

COMMENCING AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF AREA 2 DRY CREEK LAKE ANNEXATION WHICH IS NORTH 00°01'29" EAST 1235.36 FEET ALONG THE SECTION LINE AND EAST 3810.47 FEET FROM THE WEST QUARTER CORNER OF SECTION 34, TOWNSHIP 4 SOUTH, RANGE 1 EAST, SALT LAKE BASE AND MERIDIAN; THENCE NORTH 89°46'35" EAST 481.29 FEET; THENCE SOUTH 68°45'39" WEST 599.13 FEET; THENCE SOUTH 43°32'46" WEST 1243.70 FEET; THENCE SOUTH 67°28'58" WEST 464.55 FEET; THENCE SOUTH 36°51'47" WEST 519.30 FEET; THENCE NORTH 58°02'16" WEST 399.33 FEET TO THE SOUTHERLY CORNER OF AREA 1 DRY CREEK LAKE ANNEXATION.

BASIS OF BEARING: NAD 83 BEARINGS AS PER STATE PLANE COORDINATE AND DEPENDENT RESURVEY PLAT FOUND AT THE COUNTY SURVEYORS OFFICE.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> The City Council of Highland City takes notice of the enactment of an Ordinance by the City Council of Lehi City approving the proposed boundary adjustment as described above. The municipal boundary of Lehi City is hereby extended to annex the land described in SECTION 1. The Mayor, Recorder and staff of Highland City are hereby authorized to execute and file such notices, amended articles of incorporation, maps and all documents required under the provisions of Section 10-2-425, Utah Code, to complete the boundary adjustment and annexation of the land described in SECTION 1 to Lehi City.

4. This ordinance shall take effect immediately after being posted or published as required by law.

ORDINANCE NO: 06-2020

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE DRY CREEK BOUNDARY LINE ADJUSTMENT AND PUBLIC FACILITY ZONE DESIGNATION

WHEREAS, the Lehi City Council has adopted a cooperative agreement between Lehi City and Highland City and a resolution of intent to adjust the boundary line with Highland at the border of the two municipalities south of SR-92, incorporating approximately 40 acres into Lehi City. This area is further identified by Exhibit "A" pursuant to the provisions of Section 10-2-418 of the Utah Code; and

WHEREAS, the Lehi City Council conducted a public hearing on the 28th day of January, 2019, after having published notice as also required by Section 10-2-418 of the Utah Code; and

WHEREAS, the Lehi City Council noted that there were no protests filed to defeat the annexation as required by Section 10-2-418 of the Utah Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDAINED by the City Council of Lehi City, Utah, as follows:

Section 1. The Lehi City Council finds that the proposed Dry Creek Municipal Boundary Line Adjustment as more fully described on the transparent reproducible Boundary Line Adjustment Plat and the attached Exhibit "A", in the judgment of Lehi City, meets the standards set forth in Section 10-2-418 of the Utah Code.

The area as specifically described in the Boundary Line Adjustment Plat is Section 2. hereby annexed to Lehi City, subject to compliance with the terms and provisions of the Annexation Agreement, a copy of which is attached hereto.

Pursuant to Utah Code Ann. §10-9-406, the City Council hereby assigns Section 3. the PF zoning district designation to the territory depicted on the Boundary Line Adjustment Plat which is being annexed to Lehi City by this ordinance, and further directs that the Official Zoning District Map of Lehi City be amended to show the area as part of Lehi City with the new zoning district designation.

Section 4. The Mayor is hereby authorized to sign this ordinance. Once all provisions of the Boundary Line Adjustment Agreement which conditions precedent to the Adjustment are have been complied with, including the water dedication requirement described in Chapter 27 of the Lehi City Development Code, the City Recorder is directed to file the transparent reproducible Boundary Line Adjustment Plat, together with a certified copy of this ordinance in the office of the Utah County Recorder

This ordinance shall become effective on the date that it is filed in the Section 5. office of the Utah County Recorder. Lehi City
