ORDINANCE No. A20-01

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING PROPERTY KNOWN AS THE DAC-SWENSON ANNEXATION

WHEREAS, a petition has been filed with the Spanish Fork City Council by the majority of the owners representing over ½ of the property owners and 1/3 of the assessed valuation of real property hereinafter described, which property lies contiguous to the corporate limits of Spanish Fork City; and

WHEREAS, the petitioners have also submitted an accurate plat of said territory and have filed the same in the office of the Spanish Fork City

Recorder; and

WHEREAS, the Spanish Fork City Recorder has certified that the petition complies with the requirements of Utah Code Annotated §10-2-402 (1953 as amended), as they pertain to the annexation; and

WHEREAS, Spanish Fork City has accepted the petition and certified it to the Utah County Commission pursuant to Utah Code Ann. §10-2-405 on the 23rd day of October, 2019; and

WHEREAS, publication of the certification took place in the Daily Herald, a paper with local circulation in Spanish Fork City on the days of October 27th, November 3rd and 10th, 2019; and

WHEREAS, Spanish Fork City has studied the impact this annexation would have on the City, including utility impacts, infrastructure, and transportation; and

WHEREAS, no timely protests were received concerning the annexation petition; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held before the Spanish Fork City Council on the 4th day of February, 2020, pursuant to Utah Code Ann. §10-2-407, with notice having taken place in accordance with said section; and

WHEREAS, public comment was received at the public hearing from a number of individuals concerning the annexation, including its pros and cons; and

WHEREAS, the property petitioned for annexation is undeveloped, and has development concepts consistent with the Spanish Fork City Comprehensive General Plan;

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained and enacted by the Spanish Fork City Council as follows:

I.

The boundaries of Spanish Fork City are hereby extended so as to include and incorporate within the said City limits the following real property located in Utah County:

BEGINNING AT A POINTON THE EXISTING SPANISH FORK CITY BOUNDARY, SAID POINT BEING LOCATED SOUTH 36.46 FEET AND EAST 12.75 FEET FROM THE SOUTH QUARTER CORNER OF SECTION 26, TOWNSHIP 8 SOUTH, RANGE 2 EAST, SALT LAKE BASE & MERIDIAN; THENCE ALONG SAID SPANISH FORK CITY BOUNDARY THE FOLLOWINGTWO (2) COURSES: EAST 1441.63 FEET AND SOUTH 58°42'28" EAST 147.41 FEET TO THE EXISTING SALEM CITY BOUNDARY: THENCE ALONG SAID SALEM CITY BOUNDARY THE FOLLOWING SEVEN (7) COURSES: NORTH 88°40'18" WEST 79.68 FEET, NORTH 89°07'45" WEST 503.88 FEET, NORTH 86°25'45" WEST 141.24 FEET, SOUTH 89°35'56" WEST 572.47 FEET. SOUTH 89°27'41" WEST 259.52 FEET, SOUTH 5.10 FEET AND SOUTH 89°34'00" WEST 1412.26 FEET; THENCE NORTH 00°01'43" EAST 463.45 FEET; THENCE WEST 5.86 FEET; THENCE NORTH 660.00 FEET; THENCE EAST 702.37 FEET; THENCE SOUTH 00°00'55" WEST 326.54 FEET; THENCE NORTH 89°50'20" EAST 704.38 FEET TO SAID SPANISH FORK CITY BOUNDARY: THENCE ALONG SAID SPANISH FORK CITY BOUNDARY, SOUTH 718.40 FEET TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING.

AREA = 1,438,845 SQ. FT. OR 33.0313 ACRES, MORE OR LESS

That the property within the annexation outlined in red on Exhibit A is hereby zoned R-R.

III.

This Ordinance shall not become part of the Spanish Fork City Municipal Code.

IV.

This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon publication.
