

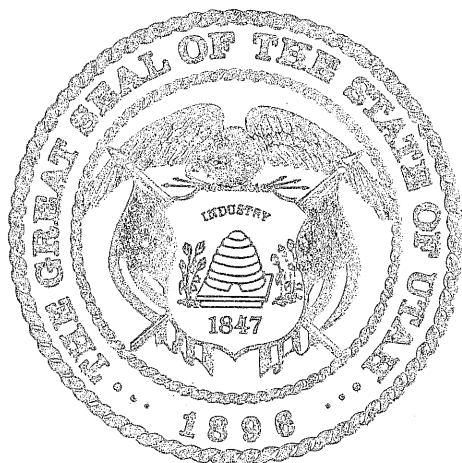

ORDINANCE 2011-1
AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY AND EXTENDING THE
CORPORATE LIMITS OF FERRON, EMERY COUNTY, UTAH KNOWN AS THE
JENKINS ANNEXATION**

WHEREAS, a majority of the owners of certain real property described below, desire to annex such real property to Ferron, Emery County, Utah, said owners being the owners of at least one-third (1/3) in value of said real property as shown by the last assessment roll; and

WHEREAS, said real property consists of approximately 2.036 acres and lies contiguous to the corporate boundaries of Ferron, Utah; and

WHEREAS, said owners have caused a petition to be filed with the City Recorder together with an accurate plat of the real property which was made under the supervision of a licensed surveyor; and

WHEREAS, Ferron City Council accepted the petition for annexation; and within 30 days the City Recorder reviewed the petition and certified that the petition meets the requirements for annexation as provided by Utah State Law (Subsections 10-2-403(2),(3), and (4)); and

WHEREAS, a notice was published once a week for three successive weeks, beginning no later than ten days after receipt of the notice of certification, in a newspaper of general circulation the area proposed for annexation and the unincorporated area within a mile of the area proposed for annexation as provided by Utah State Law (Subsection 10-2-406); and

WHEREAS, within 20 days of receipt of the notice of certification, written notices were mailed to the affected entities as provided by Utah State Law (Subsections 10-2-406(1)(b)); and

WHEREAS, no protests to the annexation petition were filed during the period specified;

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to Section 10-2-407, Utah Code, the City Council of Ferron, Utah, hereby adopts and passes the following:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF FERRON, EMERY COUNTY, UTAH AS FOLLOWS:

ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY AND EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF FERRON, EMERY COUNTY, UTAH.

1. The real property more particularly described in Paragraph 2, below, is hereby

annexed to Ferron, Emery County, Utah, and the corporate limits of Ferron, Emery County, Utah are hereby extended accordingly.

2. The real property which is the subject of this Ordinance is described as follows:

Beginning at a point located S89°21'41" W along the north line of section 15, T.20 S., R.7 E., S.L.B. & M., 297.33 feet and S00°38'19"E 919.50 feet from the northeast corner of the northwest quarter of said section 15, said point of beginning also being located at the northwest corner of tax parcel 5-87-35 and on the existing boundary of Ferron City; thence N89°21'41"E along the north line of tax parcel 5-87-35 and the existing boundary of Ferron City, 140.42 feet; thence S00°38'19"E along the east line of said tax parcel 5-87-35 631.50 feet to the southeast corner of said tax parcel 5-87-35; thence S89°21'41"W along the south line of said tax parcel 5-87-35, 140.42 feet to the southwest corner of said tax parcel 5-87-35 and the existing boundary of Ferron City; thence N00°38'19"W along the west line of said tax parcel 5-87-35, and the existing boundary of Ferron City, 631.50 feet to the point of beginning.
Containing 2.036 acres.

3. The zoning map of Ferron City shall be amended to include the real property described above in Paragraph 2.
4. The real property, described in Paragraph 2, above, shall be classified as being in the zoning district of which is designated for neighboring property in each section of which it is located in accordance with Section 10-9-406(1) of the Utah Code Annotated, 1953, as amended.
5. A certified copy of this Ordinance and an original plat setting forth the property so annexed shall be filed with the County Recorder of Emery County, Utah by the City Recorder.
6. This Ordinance shall become effective upon adoption and passage by the City Council. A copy of the Ordinance and plat shall be deposited in the Office of the City Recorder.

ENACTED by a duly constituted quorum of the Ferron City Council this 13th day of January, 2011.
