





ORDINANCE NO. 2010-02

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN RIVER, UTAH, ANNEXING BY PETITION CERTAIN PROPERTY CONTIGUOUS THERETO, BEING BEG. 576 FT W, SE COR, SW/4, SEC/4, SEC 4, TWP 21 S, R 16 E; N 265 FT; W 744 FT; S 265 FT; E 744 FT TO BEG. 4.89 ACRES AND PROVIDING FOR THE RESIDENTIAL ZONING THEREOF FOLLOWING ANNEXATION

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Green River finds that the owner of the real property described herein petitioned for annexation of the real property to the corporate limits of the City of Green River and that all required notices were given and provided to affected entities and others as required by law;

WHEREAS, the real property described herein is an unincorporated area contiguous to the current boundary of the City of Green River and the annexation will not leave or create an unincorporated island or peninsula;

WHEREAS, the City Council intentions are to protect the general interests and character of the community; assure orderly growth and development of the community in terms of utilities and public services; protect public health, safety, and welfare and ensure that annexations are approved consistent with the city General Plan and Utah state law;

WHEREAS, the City Council conducted a duly noticed public hearing on said annexation at its regularly scheduled meeting held on May 11, 2010;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Green River, Emery County, Utah:

Section 1. The following described property also known as the Silver Maple Trailer Court, contiguous to the incorporated City of Green River, and each and every part thereof be, and the same is hereby annexed to said City:

BEG. 576 FT W, SE COR, SW/4, SEC 4, TWP 21 S, R 16 E; N 265 FT; W 744; W 744 FT; S 265 FT; E 744 FT TO BEG. 4.89 ACRES.

Section 2. The corporate limits of the City of Green River be, and are hereby extended so as to include therein the said property bounded and described in Section 1 herein.

Section 3. Zoning for the described property shall be set at R-1 in conformance to the General Plan and pre-annexation zoning.

Section 4. As required by the Utah state code a certified copy of this ordinance and an original plat describing the property so annexed, shall be filed with the County Recorder within thirty (30) days after the date this ordinance is adopted.

Section 5. A certified copy of this ordinance and Amended Articles of Incorporation shall be filed with the Utah Lieutenant Governor's office along with an annexation plat describing the property annexed.
