


CERTIFICATE OF WITHDRAWAL

Pursuant to Utah Code Annotated, § 67-1a-6.7 (1953, as amended), notice is hereby given that pursuant to Utah Code Annotated, § 17D-1-603 (1953, as amended) the Washington County Commission, by Resolution No. R-2010-1513, withdrew Hurricane City and its boundary from the Hurricane Valley Fire Special Service District. A certified copy of the Resolution is attached hereto. In addition, a certified copy approved final local entity plat reflecting the boundary of the Hurricane Valley Fire Special Service District, after the withdrawal of the boundary of Hurricane City, is enclosed as well.

I hereby certify that all of the statutory requirements for withdrawal of Hurricane City and its boundary from the Hurricane Valley Fire Special Service District have been met, as outlined in Utah Code Annotated, § 17D-1-601 *et seq.* (1953, as amended).

RESOLUTION NO. R-2010-1513

A RESOLUTION WITHDRAWING HURRICANE CITY AND ITS BOUNDARY  
FROM THE HURRICANE VALLEY FIRE SPECIAL SERVICE DISTRICT

WHEREAS, on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of December 2010, the Hurricane Valley Fire Special Service District, by unanimous resolution, requested that the Washington County Commission withdraw Hurricane City and its boundary from the Hurricane Valley Fire Special Service District ("Hurricane Valley Fire SSD"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Utah Code Annotated, § 17D -1-601 (1) (1953, as amended), the legislative body of Washington County, which created the Hurricane Valley Fire SSD, may by resolution approve the withdrawal of an area from the Hurricane Valley Fire SSD if the legislative body of Washington County determines that the area should not or cannot be provided the service that the Hurricane Valley Fire SSD provides; and

WHEREAS, the Washington County Commission, which is the legislative body of Washington County that created the Hurricane Valley Fire SSD, finds that Hurricane City should not be serviced by the Hurricane Valley Fire SSD and that the boundary of Hurricane City should be withdrawn from the Hurricane Valley Fire SSD; and


WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the citizens of Washington County within the Hurricane Valley Fire SSD that Hurricane City not be serviced by the Hurricane Valley Fire SSD and that the boundary of Hurricane City be withdrawn from the Hurricane Valley Fire SSD.

NOW, THEREFORE, at a regular meeting of the legislative body of Washington County, Utah, duly called, noticed, and held on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of December 2010, upon motion duly made and seconded, it is unanimously:


RESOLVED that Hurricane City not be serviced by the Hurricane Valley Fire SSD and that the boundary of Hurricane City be withdrawn from the Hurricane Valley Fire SSD. A map of the amended boundary of the Hurricane Valley Fire SSD showing the boundary of the Hurricane Valley Fire SSD after the withdrawal of the Hurricane City Boundary, attached hereto as Exhibit "A", is hereby approved.


