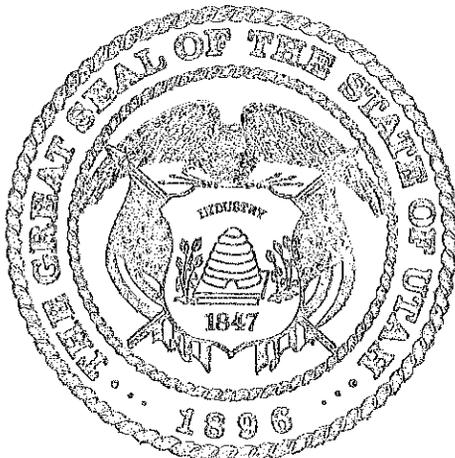

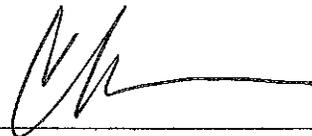
NOTICE OF IMPENDING NAME CHANGE

The District is located entirely within Garfield County, Utah.

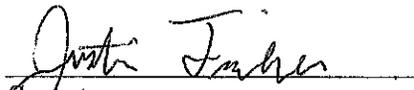
