

To the Utah Lieutenant Governor:



**RESOLUTION No. 2011-14**

**A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE DISSOLUTION OF THE WASATCH COUNTY SUBDIVISION SPECIAL SERVICE DISTRICT NO. 2**

**WHEREAS:** The Wasatch County Subdivision Special Service District No. 2 was established by Resolution No. 82-11, A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE WASATCH COUNTY SUBDIVISION SPECIAL SERVICE DISTRICT NO. 2 ("The District"), on June 4, 1982 by the Wasatch County Commission; and

**WHEREAS:** The District was created for the purpose to provide drainage, flood control and transportation (roads) services; and

**WHEREAS:** The Wasatch County Council finds that the Wasatch County Subdivision Special Service District No. 2 is no longer needed for the purposes for which it was created; and

**WHEREAS:** The Wasatch County Council also finds that there are no bonds, notes, or other obligations of the Special Service District which are outstanding or unpaid and that the District has no existing contractual obligation to provide any service; nor are there any other matters which would prohibit dissolution pursuant to Utah Code annotated 17D-1-602; and

**WHEREAS:** The Wasatch County Council finds that dissolution of the District is in the best interest of the residents of the District and the residents of Wasatch County.

**THEREFORE THE WASATCH COUNTY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

The Wasatch County Subdivision Special Service District No.2, which is described below, is no longer needed for the purpose for which it was created and is hereby dissolved.


**BEGINNING** at the Northwest corner of the South half of the Northwest quarter of Section 28, Township 4 South, Range 5 East, Salt Lake Meridian; thence East 2640 feet; thence South 5280 feet; thence west 2640 feet; thence North 5280 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning, containing Tracts 1 through 64 of Wasatch View acres Subdivision in Wasatch County, as recorded in book 47, Page 312 of the official records of Wasatch County; and



That this resolution shall be effective immediately and that pursuant to the provisions of Utah Code Annotated 17D-1-603(1)(a)(i), within 30 days of the adoption of this resolution the County Clerk shall file with the Lieutenant Governor a Notice of Impending Boundary Action as defined in Section 67-1a-6.5 and submit to the Wasatch County Recorder's office a Certificate of Dissolution upon issuance from the Lieutenant Governor's office and the original Notice of Impending Boundary Action and a certified copy of this adopted resolution approving the dissolution of The District.

This Resolution was approved and adopted on this 21 day of December, 2011.


