

The city resides entirely in Carbon County, Utah.


Please see the attached Statement by Approving Authority that all requirements for the name change have been met.

Accordingly, the city requests for a Certificate of Name Change to be issued from your office.




I, the Mayor of East Carbon – Sunnyside City, hereby certify that all requirements for the name change have been met including, but not limited to:

RESOLUTION # 3-14

A RESOLUTION CHANGING THE NAME OF
EAST CARBON-SUNNYSIDE CITY

WHEREAS, Utah Code Annotated Section 10-1-118 allows for a municipality to change its name by resolution and approval by the lieutenant governor; and

WHEREAS, The East Carbon-Sunnyside City Council has determined that following the consolidation of the Cities of East Carbon City and Sunnyside City and having received comment from the citizens of the community, the Council desires to have a name that is representative of the area, history, community, and residents;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the East Carbon-Sunnyside City Council that under Section 10-1-118 and upon the lieutenant governor's issuance of a Certificate of Name Change that East Carbon-Sunnyside City shall thereafter be known as East Carbon City.

Further, the City Council resolves that within the City limits of East Carbon City, for historic purposes, there shall be three distinct subdivisions comprising of the areas commonly known as Dragerton, Sunnyside, and Columbia.
