
CERTIFICATE OF WITHDRAWAL


NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, on the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of April 2014, the Board of Trustees of the South Valley Sewer District of Salt Lake County and Utah County passed and adopted the attached Resolution No. 04-23-14-01 providing for withdrawal of certain territory from the South Valley Sewer District known as the Highland City withdrawal of parcels, which territory is more particularly described in Section 2 of the attached Resolution Approving the Withdrawal of Territory from the District. The approved final local entity plat depicting the boundaries of the territory to be withdrawn and a legal description of that area is also filed herewith. Request is hereby made that you file in the records of your office the attached Resolution and approved final local entity plat evidencing the approved withdrawal, and that you issue a certificate of annexation. The Board of Trustees of the South Valley Sewer District hereby certifies that all requirements under the law for this withdrawal have been complied with.

RESOLUTION NO. 04-23-14-01

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING WITHDRAWAL OF CERTAIN  
TERRITORY FROM THE SOUTH VALLEY SEWER DISTRICT.**

**WHEREAS**, upon review, the Board of Trustees has determined that certain areas located within the South Valley Sewer District which are also located within Highland City will be served by Highland City through the City's sewer system; and

**WHEREAS**, the affected areas are located in Utah County, State of Utah, and are more particularly described in Exhibit A, attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees has held a public hearing pursuant to proper notice as required by law on the proposed withdrawal of territory; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees has determined that the proposed withdrawal is appropriate and desirable under the circumstances;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE  
SOUTH VALLEY SEWER DISTRICT AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1** Approval of Withdrawal of Territory from the District. The Board of Trustees of the South Valley Sewer District hereby approves the withdrawal of the area described in Exhibit A, attached hereto, from the South Valley Sewer District.

**Section 2** Filing. Within 10 days after adopting this Resolution approving the withdrawal, the Board of Trustees shall file or cause to be filed, a copy of a notice of impending boundary action and a copy of an approved final local entity plat which meet the requirements of law in the Office of the Lieutenant Governor, State of Utah. Upon the Lieutenant Governor's issuance of a certificate of withdrawal, the Board shall submit to the Utah County Recorder a) a notice of impending boundary action, b) a certificate of withdrawal, and c) an approved final local entity plat and d) a certified copy of this Resolution adopted by the Board of Trustees approving the withdrawal.


**Section 3** Effective Date. The withdrawal shall become effective upon the Lieutenant Governor's issuance of a certificate of withdrawal.
