
Dear Sir,


NOW THEREFORE be it resolved by the City Council of Hyde Park that it is their intent to adjust the common boundary of North Logan and Hyde Park as follows:

1. The following parcels shall be removed from Hyde Park's corporate boundaries and included within North Logan City's corporate boundaries - Parcels 04-058-0035, 04-058-0019, 04-058-0025, and 04-058-0020, recently acquired by the Cache County School District for the construction of a new high school;
2. The following parcels shall be removed from North Logan City's corporate boundaries and included within Hyde Park City's corporate boundaries:
 - a. The northernmost portions of parcel 04-058-0008 owned by Cache County located west of the proposed 200 East Corridor and north of an east/west line 621.1 feet south of the planned southern edge of the planned 3100 North street;
 - b. The north approximate half of parcel 04-058-0023 owned by Gene Thompson, meaning the area planned to become the planned 3100 North Street through that property; and
 - c. The area within U.S. Highway 91 north of the planned 3100 North.





WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of North Logan finds that it is in the best interest of North Logan to adjust the boundary between the City of North Logan and the City of Hyde Park; and,

WHEREAS, the boundary adjustment as set forth below will not materially injure the public in general or any person;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE NORTH LOGAN CITY COUNCIL,
AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Pursuant to Section 10-2-419, Utah Code Annotated, the following boundary line adjustment is declared:

The following parcels shall be removed from Hyde Park's corporate boundaries and included within North Logan City's corporate boundaries - Parcels 04-058-0035, 04-058-0019, 04-058-0025, and 04-058-0020, recently acquired by the Cache County School District for the construction of a new high school;

The following parcels shall be removed from North Logan City's corporate boundaries and included within Hyde Park City's corporate boundaries:

- a. The northernmost portions of parcel 04-058-0008 owned by Cache County located west of the proposed 200 East Corridor and north of an east/west line 621.1 feet south of the planned southern edge of the planned 3100 North street;
 - b. The north approximate half of parcel 04-058-0023 owned by Gene Thompson, meaning the area planned to become the planned 3100 North Street through that property; and
 - c. The area within U.S. Highway 91 north of the planned 3100 North.
