RE: NOTICE OF IMPENDING BOUNDARY ACTION

Pursuant to and in accordance with the provisions of the "Utah Municipal Code," the City of Blanding, Utah and San Juan County, Utah, acting by its Mayor and approved by the City Council during a Public Meeting held on June 10, 2014, hereby requests amendment to its Articles of Incorporation as follows:

1. The name of the municipality is the Municipal Corporation of Blanding, also known as the City of Blanding.
2. The geographical description of the City is hereby amended to include the described property attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and known as the Olsen Annexation.
3. The City of Blanding is a "City of the Fifth Class" as defined in Utah Code Ann. § 10-2-301(2)(e), having a population of more than 1,000 inhabitants, but less than 10,000 inhabitants.
4. These Amended Articles of Incorporation shall become effective on June 10, 2014.




A Resolution Establishing the Annexation of Territory Contiguous to the City of Blanding

WHEREAS, the petition and plat or map have been filed in the office of the City Recorder;


NOW BE IT THEREFORE, RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Blanding, Utah:

Section 1. **Territory annexed.**


The territory described below is hereby declared annexed to the City of Blanding:

Beginning at the NW Corner of said Section 26; thence S89°51'03"E 417.42 feet along the north line of Section 26, thence South 777.51 feet, thence West 417.42 feet to the west line of said Section 26, thence North 778.60 feet to the point of beginning, containing 7.46 acres more or less.


