Dear Lieutenant Governor Spencer J. Cox:

Pursuant to UCA §10-2a-413, §10-2a-217, and §67-1a-6.5, I hereby notify and request certification from the State of Utah of the creation of the Copperton Metro Township.

The official name of this Metro Township shall be the COPPERTON METRO TOWNSHIP. It is the intent of the Copperton Metro Township to begin operation on the Second day of January, 2017.

Since Metro Townships receive all of their municipal-type services and administrative support from local districts and Salt Lake County (UCA §10-3c-203), no new jobs will be created by the Copperton Metro Township. Therefore, the URS letter identified in UCA §67-1a-6.5(3)(d) is not required for certification.

I, Ronald V. Patrick, Chairman of the Copperton Metro Township, hereby certify the Copperton Metro Township has complied with all of the requirements applicable to the creation of the Metro Township.



**NOTICE OF IMPENDING BOUNDARY ACTION
INCORPORATION OF COPPERTON METRO TOWNSHIP**

The undersigned, as the duly elected Chairman of the Copperton Metro Township, a municipal corporation, and pursuant to Utah Code Ann. §§ 10-2a-413, 10-2a-217 (2016) and 67-1a-6.5 (2016), hereby submits the following Notice of Impending Boundary Action and Articles of Incorporation for the Copperton Metro Township. The type of boundary action for which an applicable certificate is sought is to establish the boundary of a municipality further described as the Copperton Metro Township, a municipal corporation, and its articles of incorporation.

SECTION ONE

The Name of the Metro Township shall be the Copperton Metro Township, hereafter also to be known as "Copperton."

SECTION TWO

The initial corporate boundaries of the Copperton Metro Township shall be as follows:

See Final Local Entity Plat, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION THREE

The powers of a government shall be vested in a council consisting of five-members, one of which is a chairperson, pursuant to Utah Code Ann. §10-3b-501 (2015).

SECTION FOUR


Pursuant to Utah Code Ann. § 10-2-301.5 (2015) the initial classification for Copperton shall be Metro Township.

SECTION FIVE

Pursuant to Utah Code Ann. § 67-1a-6.5 (3)(e), this Section Five certifies all requirements under Utah law applicable to incorporation of the Copperton Metro Township have been met, including and without limitation:


- A. Pursuant to a special election held on the date of November 3, 2015, a majority of residents within the area defined under said proposed incorporation, voted to incorporate the Copperton Metro Township, in compliance with Utah Code Ann. §§ 10-2a-404, 10-2a-406, and 10-2a-408 (2015).
- B. Pursuant to a special election held on the date of November 8, 2016, the residents of Copperton elected a five (5) residents to serve as members of the Copperton Metro Township Council, in compliance with Utah Code Ann. §§ 10-2a-410, 10-2a-411 and 10-2a-412 (2015)
- C. Metro Townships receive all of their municipal-type services and administrative support from local districts and Salt Lake County (UCA §10-3c-203); therefore, no new jobs will be created by the Copperton Metro Township. The URS letter identified in UCA §67-1a-6.5(3)(d) is not required.

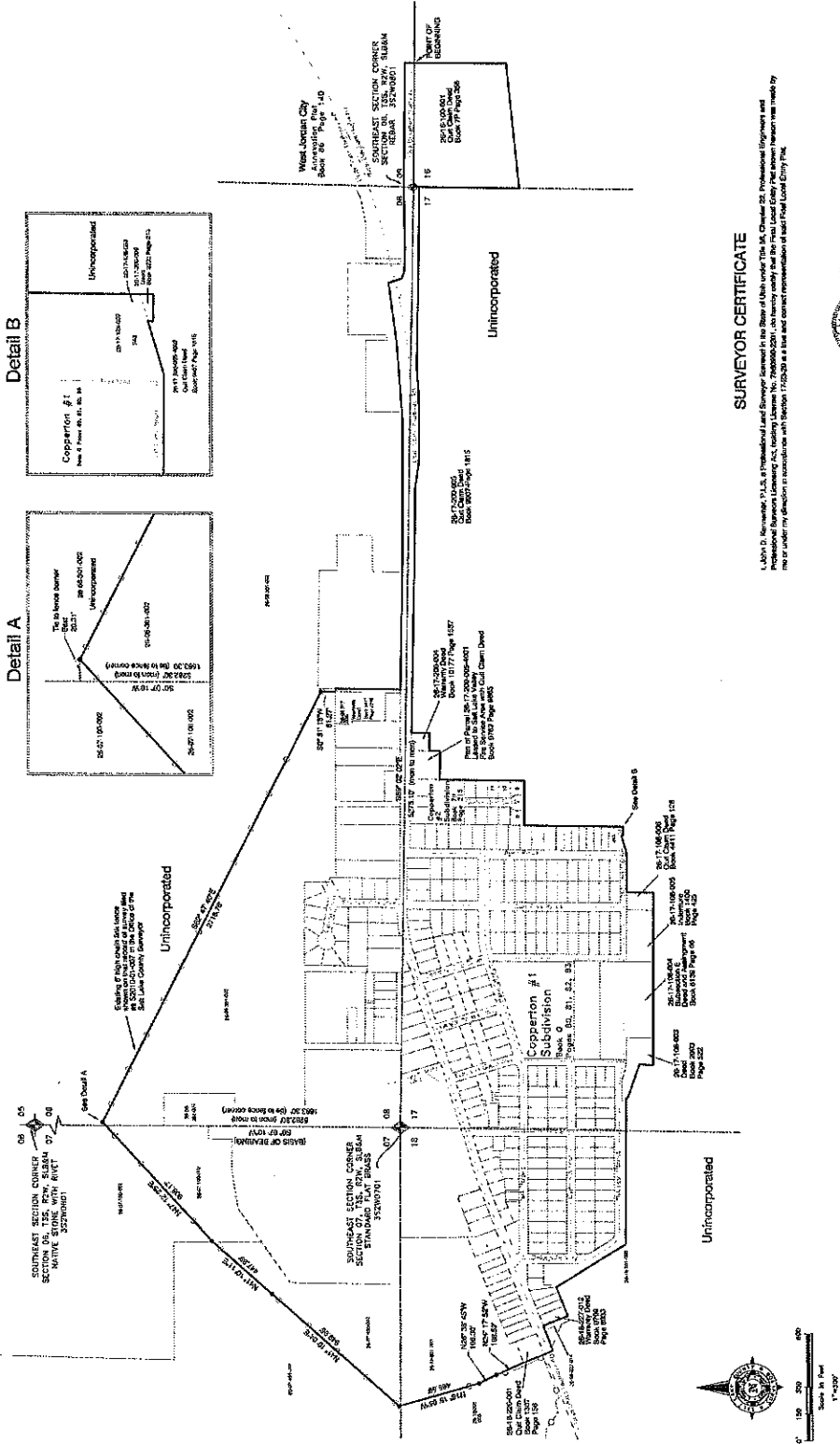

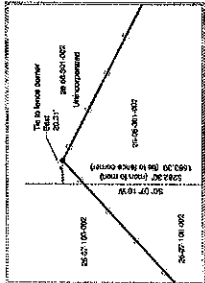



FINAL LOCAL ENTITY PLAT COPPERTON METRO TOWNSHIP

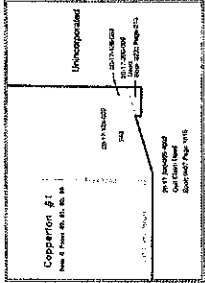

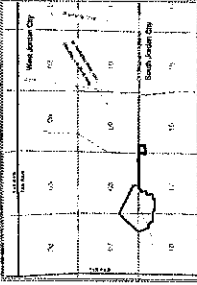
