

**RESOLUTION NO. R-2016-2002**

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE DISSOLUTION OF THE LEEDS AREA  
SPECIAL SERVICE DISTRICT**

WHEREAS, Washington County (the "County") established the Leeds Area Special Service District ("Leeds Area SSD") by Resolution Number 671 on December 1, 1997, to provide fire protection facilities and services to the corporate limits of the Town of Leeds ("Leeds Town") and the unincorporated areas adjacent to Leeds Town;

WHEREAS, on June 25, 2015, the Administrative Control Board of the Leeds Area SSD passed Resolution Number 06-25-2015 in which requested that the Washington County Commission amend the boundary of the Hurricane Valley Fire Special District ("Hurricane Valley Fire SSD" or "the District") be amended to include all real property within the boundary of the Leeds Area SDD and that fire protection, paramedic, and ambulance services in the area be provided by the Hurricane Valley Fire SSD;

WHEREAS, on October 20, 2015, the Washington County Commission passed Resolution No. R-2015-1947, which annexed the geographic area of the Leeds Area SSD into the Hurricane Valley Fire SSD;

WHEREAS, all matters related to the operation of the Leeds Area SSD have been terminated and fire services are now being fully provided by the Hurricane Valley Fire SSD;

WHEREAS, the Leeds Area SSD does not have any outstanding and unpaid bonds, notes, or other obligations, nor does it have any contractual obligation to provide any services; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSION OF WASHINGTON COUNTY, UTAH, that the commission determines the Leeds Area Special Service District is no longer needed for the purposes for which it was created.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Leeds Area Special Service District is dissolved.
