Re: Charleston Water Conservancy District Notice of Impending Boundary Action

Dear Lieutenant Governor:

My office represents the Charleston Water Conservancy District ("CWCD"), located in Wasatch County. The purpose of this letter is to comply with Utah Code Ann. §61-1a-6.5 by giving notice to your office of an impending boundary action.

CWCD is a duly organized district under Utah Code Ann. §17B, with the purpose of providing culinary water to the citizens of the Town of Charleston. CWCD has proposed and approved annexation of the areas set forth in red on the map attached as Exhibit A.

As set forth below, DeVaughn Guymon, President of CWCD, does hereby verify and certify that the following applicable requirements were all met during the process of approving the annexation:

- 1. The CWCD received a petition for annexation from owners of real property, according to Utah Code Ann. §17B-1-403(a)(ii).
- 2. In accordance with Utah Code Ann. § 17B-1-405, the CWCD board passed a resolution certifying the petition and proposing to annex into the District the area set forth in red in Exhibit A.

- 3. In accordance with Utah Code Ann. §17B-1-406, notices were sent to the Town of Charleston, the Town of Daniel, and Wasatch County. None of the entities objected to the proposed annexation.
- 4. In accordance with Utah Code Ann. §17B-1-410, notice of a public hearing was sent to all property owners within the proposed annexation area and notice was also posted in four conspicuous places within each proposed area of annexation.
- 5. In accordance with Utah Code Ann. §17B-1-409, a public hearing was held on October 12, 2017 at 6:30 pm. The proceedings of that hearing were recorded. The Board explained the proposed annexation, public comment was allowed, and the hearing was adjourned.
- 6. In accordance with Utah Code Ann. §17B-1-412, no protest was filed against the annexation.
- 7. In accordance with Utah Code Ann. §17B-1-414, the Board of CWCD met on December 7, 2017 and approved, by formal resolution, the proposed annexation. Since so much time passed before we were able to get an executed plat, the Board met again on the 18th day of December 2018 and passed an updated resolution. Copies of both of the resolutions approving the annexation are attached hereto as Exhibit B.
- 8. A formal plat map has been prepared and signed by the appropriate entities or persons.

CWCD hereby requests that your office formally recognize the annexation, and adjust the boundaries of the District to include those set forth in the formal plat map attached hereto. We also request that you issue a Certificate of Annexation, which will then be recorded, along with the Plat Map, in the office of the Wasatch County Recorder.

CHARLESTON WATER CONSERVANCY DISTRICT RESOLUTION 2018-01

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE ANNEXATION OF THE WEATHERVANE SQUARE DEVELOPMENT PROPERTY AND AUTHORIZING THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE THE ANNEXATION AGREEMENT THEREFORE

WHEREAS, Utah law authorizes Conservancy Districts to enter into annexation agreements governing the annexation of parcels of property into the District boundaries, and prescribing terms and conditions for that annexation; and

WHEREAS, on or about the 7th day of December, 2017, the Charleston Water Conservancy District adopted a formal resolution to begin the annexation process for the Weathervane Square project; and

WHEREAS, notices were duly sent and posted, and a public hearing was held, all in compliance with the requirements of the Utah Code; and

WHEREAS, no protests were received and the proscribed period for protests has passed; and

WHEREAS, the Administrative Control Board for the Charleston Water Conservancy District finds it in the public interest of the District to approve the Weathervane Square Development Annexation Petition, and to Annex the property described therein into the District, all according to the terms and conditions of the Annexation Agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it hereby RESOLVED by the Administrative Control Board of the Charleston Water Conservancy District, as follows:

Section 1: The Administrative Control Board of the Charleston Water Conservancy District hereby approves the Weathervane Square Development Annexation Petition, and annexes the property described therein into the District, subject to the execution of the Annexation Agreement pertaining thereto.

Section 2: The Administrative Control Board hereby authorizes the Chairman to execute the annexation agreement on behalf of the District.
