Re: Notice of an Impending Boundary Action, Riverton City and the City of Herriman. Request for Certificate of Boundary Adjustment.

Ms. Storie:

Pursuant to <u>Utah Code Ann.</u> §§ 10-2-425 and 67-1a-6.5, please take notice that Riverton City ("Riverton") and the City of Bluffdale ("Bluffdale") have each undertaken steps to perfect minor adjustment of the municipal boundary between these cities. A plat which provides a legal description of this boundary adjustment is enclosed with this correspondence. That said, please accept this representation that the boundary adjustment affected nothing more than an existing public right of way which exists on the border of Riverton and Bluffdale.

No privately held parcels of land will be transferred to another city as a result of this boundary adjustment. Also, the adjustment did not result in an expansion of municipal territory to the degree that either municipality will need to employ additional personnel. Accordingly, no letter is needed from the Utah State Retirement Office to identify the "potential provisions under Title 49, Utah State Retirement and Insurance Benefit Act, that the local entity shall comply with, related to the boundary action." [See Utah Code Ann. §§ 67-1a-6.5 (3)(d).]

Please accept this statement certifying that Riverton has met all requirements applicable to the boundary adjustment described in the enclosed plat. On the date of May 15, 2018, Riverton adopted Resolution No. 18-47 announcing Riverton's intention to adjust its boundary with Herriman. Riverton then published notice once per week for three successive weeks, with the first notice published within 14 days from the date Resolution 18-47 was adopted, and in compliance with Utah law. [See <u>Utah Code Ann.</u> § 10-2-419 (2) and (4).]. Finally, on the date of August 7, 2018, Riverton held a public hearing on the proposed boundary adjustment and, after receiving no written or verbal opposition to the adjustment from the public, the Riverton adopted Ordinance No. 18-32 on the date of October 2, 2018, approving the boundary adjustment. All documents needed to verify this statement are available upon request.

RIVERTON, UTAH ORDINANCE NO. 18-32

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF RIVERTON APPROVING ADJUSTMENT OF COMMON MUNICIPAL BOUNDARIES BETWEEN RIVERTON CITY AND THE CITY OF BLUFFDALE AT APPROXIMATELY 13800 SOUTH FROM 3600 WEST TO KILYE LANE

- **WHEREAS,** The Riverton City Council met in regular meeting on April 5, 2016, to consider, among other things, declaring intent to adjust the common municipal boundaries between Riverton City and the City of Herriman at approximately 13800 South from 3600 West to Kilye Lane; and
- WHEREAS, Utah Code Ann. § 10-2-419 requires that the legislative body of each municipality intending to adjust a boundary that is common with another municipality to adopt a resolution indicating the intent of said legislative body to adjust the common boundary; and
- **WHEREAS**, Resolution No. 18-37 was adopted by the Riverton City Council on the date of April 17, 2018 declaring the intent of Riverton City to adjust its boundary in common with the City of Bluffdale as described in that Resolution; and
- **WHEREAS**, Riverton City published notice of its intent to hold a public hearing to address adjustment of its common boundary with Herriman City in compliance with Utah Code Ann. § 10-2-419; and
- WHEREAS, the Riverton City Council found and determined that, as of the conclusion of said public hearing on the date of June 7, 2016, Riverton City has not received written protests to the adjustment filed by owners of private real property that: is located within the area proposed for adjustment; covers at least 25% of the total private land area within the area proposed for adjustment; or is equal in value to at least 15% of the value of all private real property within the area proposed for adjustment; and
- **WHEREAS,** Riverton City, and the City of Bluffdale desire to adjust their common boundaries at approximately 13800 South from 3600 West to Kilye Lane. A map showing the locations of the adjustments of the properties is attached hereto; and
- WHEREAS, the Council finds and determines the proposed boundary adjustment will promote a more efficient delivery of municipal services, and
- **WHEREAS**, the Council hereby approves the adjustment with its common boundary with Herriman; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Council finds that the boundary adjustment meets the standards established by UTAH CODE ANN. 10-2-419, and

WHEREAS, the Council desires to re-adopt this Ordinance to insure timely delivery of the adopted ordinance to the Lieutenant Governor's Office within thirty (30) days of adoption pursuant to relevant Utah State Code.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Council hereby adjusts the common boundaries between Riverton City and the City of Bluffdale, as indicated on the attached map, more particularly described in the legal description on the attached map.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor direct appropriate City staff to file with the lieutenant governor's office: a notice of impending boundary action, in compliance with Utah Code Ann. § 67-1a-6.5 (3); and a copy of a local entity plat describing the boundary so adjusted.

ORDINANCE NO. 2018-22

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE ADJUSTMENT OF A COMMON MUNICIPAL BOUNDARY WITH RIVERTON CITY.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Utah Code Ann. § 10-2-419, the legislative bodies of two or more municipalities having common boundaries may adjust their common boundaries;

WHEREAS the City of Bluffdale and Riverton City share a common boundary and intend to adjust the boundary;

WHEREAS the City of Bluffdale passed a resolution on April 25, 2018, and Riverton City passed a resolution on May 15, 2018, stating its intent to adjust a common boundary;

WHEREAS the City of Bluffdale has posted appropriate notice according to Utah Code Ann. § 10-2-419(2);

WHEREAS, on June 13, 2018, the City of Bluffdale held a public hearing regarding the adjustment of a common boundary; and

WHEREAS the City of Bluffdale has received no protests that meet the requirements of Utah Code Ann. § 10-2-419(3);

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BLUFFDALE CITY COUNCIL HEREBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

- **Section 1.** Adjustment of the Common Boundary. The City Council hereby approves the adjustment of a municipal boundary between the City of Bluffdale and Riverton City as represented in Exhibit A.
- **Section 2. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall take effect when Riverton City has adopted a similar ordinance approving the boundary adjustment.

An adjustment to the municipal boundary of Riverton and Bluffdale Cities, as described in that Articles of Incorporation recorded October 16, 1947 as Entry No. 1098619 in Book 568 at Page 5, that Articles of Incorporation recorded November 29, 1978 as Entry No. 3204111 in Book 4778 at Page 1319 and amended by that Order of Disconnection recorded on November 21, 2007 as Entry No. 10282763 in Book 9540 at Page 3737 in the office of the Salt Lake County Recorder. Said municipal boundary adjustment is located in Sections 3, 4, and 5 of Township 4 South, Range 1 West of the Salt Lake Base and Meridian, and described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the current Riverton and Bluffdale City municipal boundary line at the Center Quarter Corner of said Section 5, Township 4 South Range 1 West, Salt Lake Base and Meridian, ; thence departing said current municipal boundary line South 89°51'17" East along the quarter section line 33.00 feet to the east right-of-way line of 3600 West Street;

thence North 00°15'45" East 658.33 feet along said east right of way line to intersect the control line of State Road 154 (Bangerter Highway) as established by UDOT project SP-0154(9); thence along said control line the following eight (8) courses:

- 1) Southeasterly, 1,923.37 feet along the arc of a 3280.83-foot radius non-tangent curve to the left, through a central angle of 33°35'22" (center of said curve bears N 33°49'58" E, chord bears South 72°57'43" East 1895.94 feet);
- 2) South 89°45'24" East 1466.90 feet to the point of tangency with a 3280.83-foot radius curve to the right;
- 3)Southeasterly along the arc of said curve 609.53 feet through a central angle of 10°38'41" (chord bears South 84°26'04" East 608.65 feet);
- 4) South 79°06'43" East 530.88 feet to the point of tangency with a 3280.83-foot radius curve to the left:
- 5) Easterly along the arc of said curve 595.76 feet through a central angle of 10°24'15" (chord bears South 84°18'51" East 594.94 feet);
- 6) South 89°30'58" East 2080.99 feet to the point of tangency with a 3280.83-foot radius curve to the left;
- 7) Northeasterly along the arc of said curve 527.06 feet, through a central angle of 9°12'16" (chord bears North 85°52'54" East 526.49 feet);
- 8) North 81°16'46" East 283.65 feet to intersect the east line of said Section 4 and said current Riverton and Bluffdale City municipal boundary line, said point being 11.86 feet South 00°29'03" West of the East Quarter Corner of said section 4;

thence departing said control line of State Road 154, Southerly, Easterly, and Northerly along said current municipal boundary line the following seven (7) courses:

- 1) South 00°29'03" West along said section line 208.83 feet;
- 2) South 89°32'19" East 198.00 feet along the south boundary of Parcel id# 33-03-301-048;
- 3) South 00°27'42" West 220.69 feet along the west boundary of Parcel id# 33-03-301-083;
- 4) South 89°32"19" East 214.50 feet along the south boundary of Parcel id#s 33-03-301-083 and 33-03-301-072:
- 5) South 00°27'42" West 556.88 feet along the west boundary of Parcel id#s 33-03-301-073 and 33-03-301-075:
- 6) South 89°32'22" East 577.50 feet along the south boundary of Parcel id# 33-03-301-075;
- 7) North 00°13'11" East 1102.82 feet along the east boundary of Parcel id#s 33-03-301-075, 33-03-301-076; 33-03-301-074, 33-03-301-005, 33-03-301-007 and a northerly extension thereof to intersect the control line of State Road 154 (Bangerter Highway) established by UDOT project S-0154(75)3 and shown on that record of survey filed as S2016-01-0102 in the office of the Salt Lake County Surveyor;

thence Easterly along said control line the following three (3) courses:

- 1) Easterly along the arc of a 8530.02-foot radius non-tangent curve to the right, through a central angle of 07°08'51" (center of said curve bears South 03° 04' 54" East, chord bears South 89°30'29" East 1063.42 feet)
- 2) South 85°56'03" East 946.35 feet to the point of tangency with a 2625.01-foot radius curve to the right;
- 3) Southeasterly 328.71 feet along the arc of said curve to intersect the east-west quarter section line of said Section 3 and said current Bluffdale and Riverton City municipal boundary line at the westerly corner of the Corporate Boundary Adjustment / Annexation by and between Riverton City and Bluffdale City recorded as Entry No. 9782021 on July 13, 2006 in Book 2006P at Page 195 in the office of said Recorder, being the point of terminus.
