ORDINANCE 18-30 (Jaques Annexation)

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING REAL PROPERTIES LOCATED AT APPROXIMATELY 1300 EAST 3000 NORTH INTO THE CITY AND EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF LAYTON CITY; PROVIDING FOR REPEALER, SEVERABILITY, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City has determined that the properties located at approximately 1300 East 3000 North are part of an existing unincorporated parcel of property contiguous to Layton City; and

WHEREAS, these properties are identified in the Layton City Annexation Policy Plan, Expansion Area Two, adopted by the City Council on December 5, 2002; and

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted Resolutions 18-38 and 18-39 expressing Layton City's intent to annex said properties; and

WHEREAS, a plat of said real properties has been prepared under the supervision of a competent surveyor, showing the size and location of said real properties and showing that the same is contiguous to the present corporate limits of Layton City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that in their judgment, this annexation meets the standards set forth in the Utah State Code, and the noticing requirements therein have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, the Layton City Council deems it to be in the best interest of the City and its citizens to annex the real property described herein to Layton City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF LAYTON, UTAH:

<u>SECTION I:</u> **Repealer.** If any provisions of the City's Code heretofore adopted are inconsistent herewith they are hereby repealed.

<u>SECTION II:</u> Enactment. That the following described real property is hereby annexed into Layton City, and the corporate limits of the City are hereby extended to include said real property:

BEGINNING AT THE NORTH QUARTER CORNER OF SECTION 10, TOWNSHIP 4 NORTH, RANGE 1 WEST, SALT LAKE BASE AND MERIDIAN; AND RUNNING THENCE SOUTH 00°07'30" WEST ALONG THE SECTION LINE 368.90 FEET; THENCE NORTH 83°33'09" WEST 150.00 FEET; THENCE SOUTH 7°12'48" EAST 390.35 FEET TO THE NORTH RIGHT-OF-WAY LINE OF STATE HIGHWAY NO. 193, WHICH IS ALSO A POINT ON A 5,654.65 FOOT RADIUS NON-TANGENT CURVE: THENCE NORTHWESTERLY ALONG SAID NORTH RIGHT-OF-WAY LINE 540.17 FEET ALONG SAID ARC TO THE RIGHT AND THROUGH A CENTRAL ANGLE OF 05°28'24" (WHICH RADIUS POINT BEARS NORTH 04°23'47" EAST AND LONG CHORD BEARS NORTH 82°52'01" WEST 539.96 FEET) TO A POINT ON THE EAST LINE OF THE JAQUES PROPERTY AS DESCRIBED IN THAT CERTAIN QUIT CLAIM DEED RECORDED DECEMBER 12, 1994 AS ENTRY NO. 1158217; THENCE NORTHERLY ALONG SAID EAST LINE AND THE CONTINUATION THEREOF TO THE SECTION LINE THE FOLLOWING FIVE (5) COURSES: NORTH 02°03'04" WEST 146.87 FEET; THENCE NORTH 02°35'53" EAST 131.19 FEET; THENCE NORTH 02°38'00" WEST 99.99 FEET; THENCE NORTH 89°52'30"

WEST 20.11 FEET; THENCE NORTH 00°07'30" EAST 298.41 FEET TO THE NORTH SECTION LINE OF SAID SECTION 10; THENCE SOUTH 89°39'40" EAST ALONG SAID SECTION LINE 660.00 FEET TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING.

CONTAINS 416,714.68 SQ/FT OR 9.566 ACRES.

SECTION III: Filing. The City Recorder is directed to file a certified copy of the plat of said real property and a certified copy of this ordinance of annexation with the Davis County Recorder; and within 30 days after the enactment hereof, the City Council shall file with the Lieutenant Governor a notice of impending boundary action, as defined in Section 67-1a-6.5 UCA that meets the requirements of Section 67-1a-6.5(3) UCA and a copy of an approved final plat, as defined in Section 67-1a-6.5.

<u>SECTION IV</u>: Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, said portion shall be severed and such declaration shall not affect the validity of the remainder of the said ordinance.

<u>SECTION V:</u> Effective date. This ordinance shall go into effect at the expiration of the 20^{th} day after publication or posting or the 30^{th} day after final passage as noted below or whichever of said days is more remote from the date of passage thereof.
