RESOLUTION NO. R-2019-2427

A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE BOUNDARY OF THE HURRICANE VALLEY FIRE SPECIAL SERVICE DISTRICT TO INCLUDE THE AREA WITHIN THE ROCKVILLE-SPRINGDALE FIRE SPECIAL SERVICE DISTRICT

WHEREAS, Washington County (the "County") established the Rockville–Springdale Fire Protection District ("Rockville–Springdale Fire SSD") by Resolution Number 356 in February 1983, to provide fire protection services to the corporate limits of the Towns of Rockville and Springdale;

WHEREAS, the County established the Hurricane Valley Fire Special Service District ("Hurricane Valley Fire SSD") by Resolution Number R-2007-1203 in December 2007, to provide fire protection, paramedic, and ambulance services within an area that included the corporate limits of Hurricane City, LaVerkin City, Toquerville City and Virgin Town, along with portions of the unincorporated areas of Washington County adjacent to these municipalities;

WHEREAS, the boundary of the Hurricane Valley Fire SSD has been expanded to now include the municipalities of Hurricane, LaVerkin, Toquerville, Leeds, and Virgin, and the vast majority of the unincorporated areas in the County east of Interstate 15—including the unincorporated areas surrounding Rockville and Springdale;

WHEREAS, currently, the Rockville-Springdale Fire SSD contracts with the Hurricane Valley Fire SSD to fulfill its fire and emergency services responsibilities;

WHEREAS, the voters in the Rockville-Springdale Fire SSD and the Hurricane Valley Fire SSD previously approved the imposition of a tax levy to fund emergency services;

WHEREAS, the Rockville-Springdale Fire SSD annually charges a standby fee to properties in its boundary in addition to the tax levy;

WHEREAS, on October 2, 2018 by Resolution Number R-2018-2382 the Washington County Commission proposed that boundary of the Hurricane Valley Fire SSD be amended to include the area currently serviced by the Rockville-Springdale Fire SSD;

WHEREAS, the Washington County Commission held a properly noticed public hearing to take public comment on the proposed amendment on November 13, 2018, at the Springdale Town Hall (The notice is attached as Exhibit A.) where five people spoke in opposition to the proposed amendment and no one spoke in favor of it; and

WHEREAS, the sixty-day protest period for the proposed amendment has ended; 57 protests were received by eligible voters or property owners; and the protests represented 10.22% of the number of votes cast in Rockville and Springdale for the office of President of the United States at the most recent election and 5.23% of the total private

land area and 4.95% of the value of all private real property within Rockville and Springdale (The Washington County Clerk–Auditor's summary of the protests is attached as Exhibit B.);

WHEREAS, the protests are insufficient to statutorily prevent the proposed amendment (which requires protests representing 25% of the number of votes cast in Rockville and Springdale for the office of President of the United States at the most recent election or 25% of the total private land area and 15% of the value of all private real property within Rockville and Springdale);

WHEREAS, with the approval of this Resolution, the legal requirements for amending the Hurricane Valley Fire SSD have been met;

WHEREAS, it is expected that the proposed boundary adjustment will increase the efficiency of providing fire protection, paramedic, and ambulance services to the areas affected by the proposed boundary amendment;

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the citizens of Washington County within the Hurricane Valley Fire SSD and the Rockville–Springdale Fire SSD that the proposed boundary adjustment be carried out; and

WHEREAS, the attached map (Exhibit C) and amended boundary description (Exhibit D) accurately describe the proposed boundary adjustment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE COUNTY COMMISSION OF WASHINGTON COUNTY, that the boundary of the Hurricane Valley Fire Special Service District is amended to include the area within the Rockville–Springdale Fire SSD as shown in the attached map (Exhibit C) and boundary description (Exhibit D).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Rockville–Springdale Fire SSD shall levy its 2019 property tax and standby fee to fund emergency services for 2019; Hurricane Valley Fire SSD shall not levy a tax or charge a fee on property located within the Rockville–Springdale Fire SSD until 2020.


Beginning at a point on the South Boundary line of the State of Utah said point being the Southwest Corner of Section 36, Township 43 South, Range 15 West, Salt Lake Base and Meridian and running, thence East along the South Boundary line of the State of Utah to the Southeast Corner of Section 35, Township 43 South, Range 12 West, SLB&M; thence North along the East line of Sections 35 and 26 to a point on the top edge of the ledges on the South side of Little Creek Mountain; thence along the top of the ledges through the following Sections 26, 24, 23, 14, 22, 21, 28, 20, 19, and 18, Township 43 South, Range 12 West, SLB&M; thence along the top of the ledges through Sections 13 and 12, Township 43 South, Range 13 West, SLB&M; thence along the top of the ledges through Sections 7 and 6, Township 43 South, Range 12 West; thence along the top of the ledges through Section 32, Township 42 South, Range 12 West, and Section 5, Township 43 South, Range 12 West, to a point on the East line of Section 5; thence North along the East line of Section 5, Township 43 South, Range 12 West, to the Northeast Corner of said Section 5; thence East along the South line Township 42 South, Range 12 West, to the Southeast Corner of Section 32, Township 42 South, Range 12 West; thence North along the East lines of Sections 32, 29, 20 and 16, Township 42 South, Range 12 West, SLB&M, to a point on the Northwest Corner of the Apple Valley Municipal Boundary in Section 16; thence Easterly along the Municipal boundary line through the following Sections: 16, 21, 22, 27, and 23, to a point on the East Section line of Section 23, Township 42 South, Range 12 West, SLB&M; thence North along the East line of Sections 23 and 14 to the Northeast Corner of Section 14, Township 42 South, Range 12 West, SLB&M; thence East along the South Section line of Section 12, Township 42 South, Range 12 West; thence North along the East Section lines of Sections 12 and 1, Township 42 South, Range 12 West, to the Southwest Corner of Township 41 South, Range 11 West; thence East along the South line of Township 41 South, Range 11 West to the Southeast Corner of said Township; thence North along the East lines of Township 41 South, Range 11 West and Township 40 South, Range 11 West and Township 39 South, Range 11 West to the Southwest Corner of Township 39 South, Range 10 West; thence East along the South line of Township 39 South, Range 10 West, to the Southeast Corner of Section 34, Township 39 South, Range 10 West; thence North along the East Section line of Sections 34, 27, 22, 15, 10, and 3, Township 39 South, Range 10 West, to the Southeast Corner of Section 34, Township 38 South, Range 10 West; thence North along the East Section line of Sections 34, 27, and 22, to the Northeast Corner of Section 22, Township 38 South, Range 10 West, said point being on the North Boundary line of Washington County; thence West along the North Section lines and North Boundary line of Washington County to the Northwest Corner of Section 19, Township 38 South, Range 10 West, said point being on the West Range line of Township 38 South, Range 10 West; thence South along said Range line and Washington County Boundary line to the Northeast Corner of Section 24, Township 38 South, Range 11 West; thence West along the Washington County Boundary line and North Section lines of Sections 24, 23, 22, 21, 20, and 19, to the Northwest Corner of Section 19, Township 38 South, Range 11 West; thence South along the Range line through Township 38 South and Township 39 South, to the Northeast Corner of Section 13, Township 39 South, Range 12 West; thence West along the North Section lines of Sections 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, and 18, to a point on the East line of Section 13, Township 39 South, Range 13 West; thence


