A RESOLUTION OF THE HYDE PARK CITY COUNCIL REAPPROVING ORDINANCE 2018-08 AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING .61 ACRES PURSUANT TO SECTION 10-2-407, U.A.C. AS REQUESTED BY PROPERTY OWNER MICHAEL COOK

WHEREAS, THE Hyde Park City Council, by Ordinance 2018-08 dated May 23, 2018, approved the Annexation request for .61 acres as requested by Michael Cook

Hyde Park City Ordinance 2018 - 08

An Ordinance Annexing 0.61 Acres pursuant to Section 10-2-407, U.A.C as Requested by Michael Cook

The City Council of Hyde Park, Utah, in a regular meeting, at which lawful notice was given, finds that in this particular instance, the City adopt an ordinance annexing .061 acres more or less of property, into the Hyde park City corporate limits.

Be if therefore ordained by the Hyde Park City Council that the 0.61 acres more or less of property described as follows:

A PART OF THE NORTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 3 AND THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 3, TOWNSHIP 13 NORTH, RANGE 1 EAST OF THE SALT LAKE BASE AND MERIDIAN. BEGINNING AT A POINT ON THE EXISTING NORTH LINE OF THE HYDE PARK CITY CORPORATE LIMITS, WHICH BEARS SOUTH 15'54'18" EAST A DISTANCE OF 2943.47 FEET FROM THE 3.5" CACHE COUNTY ALUMINUM MONUMENT MARKING THE NORTH ¼ CORNER OF SAID SECTION 3; THENCE ALONG THE CENTERLINE OF 500 EAST STREET THE FOLLOWING (2) COURSES: (1) NORTH 1'49'00" EAST, A DISTANCE OF 2.51 FEET; (2) NORTH 1'09'19" EAST, A DISTANCE OF 117.78 FEET; THENCE LEAVING SAID CENTERLINE OF 500 EAST STREET SOUTH 88'31'24" EAST, A DISTANCE OF 221.40 FEET; THENCE SOUTH 1'06'45" WEST, A DISTANCE OF 120.096 FEET TO THE EXISTING NORTH LINE OF THE HYDE PARK CITY CORPORATE LIMITS; THENCE ALONG SAID NORTH LINE OF THE HYDE PARK CITY COORPERATE LIMITS NORTH 88'34'21" WEST, A DISTANCE OF 221.51 FEET TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING.

CONTAINING 0.61 ACRES

Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon passage by the City Council of Hyde Park City, Utah.





Survey Narrative
The purpose of this survey was to create an annexation plat to annex parcel 04–007–0033 into the Hyde Park City Limits. The survey was ordered by Michael Cook. The control used to establish the property corners was the survey monumentation found from various surveys. The basis of bearings for this survey was the line between the north ½ corner and the northwest corner of Section 3, Township 13 North, Range 1 East, which bears \$89.52.09 W (found Cache County Surveyor monuments).





ANNEXATION PLAT


