ORDINANCE NO. 01-2019

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEHI CITY, UTAH RE-APPROVING ADJUSTING ITS COMMON BOUNDARIES WITH SARATOGA SPRINGS, UTAH

WHEREAS, Utah Code § 10-2-419 establishes the procedure for adjusting the common boundaries between adjacent municipalities; and

WHEREAS, the City of Saratoga Springs, Utah shares common boundaries with Lehi City, Utah; and

WHEREAS, a portion of Lehi's 2300 West is contiguous with the incorporated limits of Saratoga Springs and is currently being used to access properties located in Saratoga Springs, which portion of property is more specifically described on Exhibit A ("Property"); and

WHEREAS, Saratoga Springs and Lehi City have mutually determined that the Property is better suited to be within the incorporated limits of Saratoga Springs because the Property is adjacent to Saratoga Springs' development and Saratoga Springs should be responsible for the repair, maintenance, and replacement of the road located on the Property; and

WHEREAS, due to the reasons above, Saratoga Springs and Lehi City desire to adjust their municipal boundaries as provided by State law so that the Property can be added to the municipal boundaries of Saratoga Springs and owned and maintained by Saratoga Springs; and

WHEREAS, a legal description and plat has been prepared for the boundary adjustment, which legal description and plat are attached as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, Lehi City submitted the Notice of Impending Boundary Action to the Lieutenant Governor's Office on February 15, 2017 and the Lieutenant ant Governor's office sent Lehi City an e-mail stating that Utah Code specifies that the Notice of Impending Boundary Action must be submitted to them within 30 days of after enacting the ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Lehi City Council's intent is to re-approve the Boundary Line Adjustment for resubmittal to the Lieutenant Governor's office for approval.

NOW THEREFORE, after posting the requisite public notice and holding the requisite public hearing as provided by Utah law, and after finding that the boundary adjustment furthers the health, safety, and general welfare of the City of Saratoga Springs, Utah, the City Council ordains as follows:

SECTION I – ENACTMENT

After holding the requisite public hearing, the City Council, in accordance with Utah Code § 10-2-419, adjusts its common boundaries with Lehi City. The City Council finds that the boundary adjustment promotes the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the City of Saratoga Springs by properly shifting the ownership and obligations to maintain the road located

on the Property to Saratoga Springs. A legal description and map showing the location of the adjustment area are attached as Exhibit A to this Ordinance. No protests were received to this action.

SECTION II – REPEALER

If any provisions of the Lehi City Code are inconsistent with this ordinance they are hereby repealed.

SECTION III – AMENDMENT OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES

To the extent that any ordinances, resolutions, or policies of the City of Lehi conflict with the provisions of this ordinance, they are hereby amended to comply with this ordinance.

SECTION IV – EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall take effect following publication.

SECTION V – SEVERABILITY

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this ordinance is, for any reason, held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such provision shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

Dear Lieutenant Governor Cox,

On November 13, 2018, the City Council of the City of Saratoga Springs, Utah adopted Ordinance No. 18-35 (11-13-18) adjusting its common boundary with Lehi City, Utah. Since 30 days elapsed from the approval date of the Ordinance due to requested amendment of the plat by the County Surveyor, the Saratoga Springs City Council re-approved the boundary adjustment on January 15, 2019 adopting Ordinance 2019-1 (1-15-19).

This adjustment pertains to a portion of Lehi's 2300 West ("Property") that is contiguous with the incorporated limits of Saratoga Springs and is currently used to access properties located in Saratoga Springs. The cities of Saratoga Springs and Lehi have mutually determined that the Property is better suited to be within the incorporated limits of Saratoga Springs because the Property is adjacent to Saratoga Springs' development and Saratoga Springs should be responsible for the repair, maintenance, and replacement of road located on the Property. In accordance with Utah State Code § 10-2-425, a copy of the approved final local entity plat and a certified copy of Saratoga Springs Ordinance No. 18-35 (11-13-18) is attached. It is my understanding the City of Lehi will be providing their Notice and Ordinance to your office.

I also respectfully request that your office issue a Certificate of Boundary Adjustment to the cities of Saratoga Springs and Lehi in accordance with Utah Code § 10-2-425.

This ordinance shall take effect following publication of a short summary of the ordinance in the Provo Daily Herald on one occasion as required by Utah Code § 10-3-711 and following the proper filing, recording, and notice required in Utah Code § 10-2-425.

SECTION V – SEVERABILITY

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this ordinance is, for any reason, held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such provision shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

SECTION VI – PUBLIC NOTICE

The Saratoga Springs Recorder is hereby ordered, in accordance with the requirements of Utah Code §§ 10-3-710—711, to do as follows:

- a. deposit a copy of this ordinance in the office of the City Recorder; and
- b. publish notice as follows:
 - i. publish a short summary of this ordinance for at least one publication in a newspaper of general circulation in the City; or
 - ii. post a complete copy of this ordinance in three public places within the City.
