NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of Directors of the Powder Mountain Water and Sewer Improvement District (the "District"), at a regular meeting of the Board, duly convened pursuant to notice, on January 15, 2019, adopted a Resolution Approving Petition for Annexation, Resolution # 2019-03, a true and correct copy of which is attached as Exhibit A hereto and incorporated by this reference herein (the "Annexation Resolution").

A copy of the Final Local Entity Plat satisfying the applicable legal requirements as set forth in Utah Code Ann. § 17-23-20, approved as a final local entity plat by the Surveyor of Weber County, Utah, is attached hereto as Exhibit B and incorporated by this reference. The District hereby certifies that all requirements applicable to the annexation of the property into the legal boundaries of the District, as more particularly described in the Annexation Resolution and Utah Code Ann. § 17B-1-401 *et seq.*, have been met.

WHEREFORE, the District hereby respectfully requests the issuance of a Certificate of Annexation pursuant to and in conformance with the provisions in Utah Code Ann. §§ 17B-1-414(2)(c) and 67-1a-65.

RESOLUTION RE-ADOPTING RESOLUTION # 2018-16 APPROVING PETITION FOR ANNEXATION

RESOLUTION # 2019-03

WHEREAS, the Powder Mountain Water and Sewer Improvement District met on January 15, 2019 to consider, among other things, re-adopting Resolution # 2018-16 Approving Petition for Annexation from SMHG Landco, LLC; and

WHEREAS, the District met on November 20, 2018 to consider, among other things, approving an August 22, 2018 petition from SMHG Landco, LLC to annex property; and

WHEREAS, SMHG Landco, LLC owns 100% of the land proposed to be annexed; and

WHEREAS, the District certified the petition to Weber County pursuant to Utah Code § 17B-1-405 and notified the County of the proposed annexation pursuant to Utah Code § 17B-1-406(1) on September 21, 2018; and

WHEREAS, Weber County did notify the District that it intends to consider providing services to the propose annexed area pursuant to Utah Code § 17B-1-407(1)(a); and

WHEREAS, the time for the County to notify the District of such an intent (30 days from the date of notice) had passed; and

WHEREAS, the District posted notices of the annexation pursuant to Utah Code § 17B-1-413(2)(b) on October 23, 2018;

WHEREAS, the District did not receive any requests for a public hearing under Utah Code § 17B-1-413(2)(a)(ii)(B); and

WHEREAS, the time for making such requests (20 days from the posting of notices) had passed; and

WHEREAS, based on the foregoing, the District adopted Resolution # 2018-16 Approving Petition for Annexation on November 20, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the District filed the Notice of Impending Boundary Action and required attachments with the office of the Lt. Governor on January 11, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the Lt. Governor's office responded that Resolution # 2018-16 had to be readopted in order to comply with the timing restrictions in § 17B-1-414(2)(a)(ii)(A); and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Powder Mountain Water and Sewer Improvement District as follows:



- 1. Resolution # 2018-16 is re-adopted and incorporated by reference herein.
- 2. The SMHG Landco, LLC petition to annex property is approved.
- 3. The District shall re-submit the requisite documents to the Lt. Governor's office to obtain a certificate of annexation within 30 days of this Resolution.




