ORDINANCE NO. 2019-12

AN ORDINANCE OF IVINS CITY, UTAH, ADJUSTING THE MUNICIPAL BOUNDARY LINE BETWEEN IVINS CITY AND SANTA CLARA CITY

WHEREAS, IVINS CITY received a request from property owner ENLAW, LLC, by and through its representative owner/member Patrick Manning, to consider a boundary line adjustment between Ivins City and Santa Clara City regarding approximately 6.05 acres of property located at the most northern and eastern boundary of Santa Clara City (current APN SC-6-2-4-2221); and

WHEREAS, the property owner has requested this consideration due to access to utility services for a future residential subdivision; and

WHEREAS, Utah Code Annotated §10-2-419 allows for municipalities having a common boundary to adjust that common boundary by adopting a resolution indicating the intent to adjust the boundary and by subsequently holding a public hearing before approving the common boundary adjustment by ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Ivins City Council adopted a Resolution stating intent to adjust its common boundary with Santa Clara on September 5, 2019, and held a public hearing on this request on November 7, 2019;

WHEREAS, the Ivins City Council has determined that it would be in the best interest of Ivins City to adjust its common boundary with Santa Clara City to move the 6.05 parcel of property currently within the municipal boundaries of Santa Clara City into the municipal boundaries of Ivins City; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Ivins City Council that the Ivins City municipal boundary be adjusted, pursuant to Utah Code Annotated §10-2-419, to now include the property described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto.

Effective Date: This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage and publication.



CITY OF SANTA CLARA ORDINANCE 2019-12

AN ORDINANCE RESUBMITTING THE ADJUSTMENT OF THE MUNICIPAL BOUNDARY LINE BETWEEN IVINS CITY AND SANTA CLARA CITY.

WHEREAS, this Ordinance must be re-adopted and submitted to the Lieutenant Governor's Office within 60 days of its adoption meeting the (Utah Code 10-2-425), and

WHEREAS, the City of Santa Clara has received a request from Patrick Manning, representative of property owner Split Rock Inc., to consider a boundary line adjustment with the City of Ivins to transfer approximately 6 acres from Santa Clara City to Ivins City described in Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, the property owner has requested this consideration, due to access to utility services for a future residential subdivision; and

WHEREAS, Utah Code Annotated § 10-2-419 allows for municipalities having a common boundary to adjust the boundary by adopting a resolution indicating the intent to adjust the boundary, and to give subsequent notice of the intent, and hold a public hearing as required by law; and

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted such a resolution on January 8, 2020, and held a public hearing on this request on August 14, 2019; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Santa Clara, the City Municipal Boundary is adjusted, pursuant to Utah Code Annotated § 10-2-419 as described on the attached property legal description, Exhibit "A." This Ordinance is effective on the date executed below.






